We will be advertising this event in the school and through the community. So get your friends and neighbors to save up there donations for us. Goodwill will be issuing donation slips at this event.

Renee let us know she and Cindy met with a production company to handle Grad Night.

They will do decorations, set up and tear down. They can also provide zip lines, laser tag, arcade games, photo booth etc. They fully insured which makes it really good.

We asked Rebecca, our treasurer, how many tickets were generally sold for Grad Night. She reported an average of 150-170. At \$100 a ticket, this will add approx. \$15,000 to our funds to help cover the cost of the event.

We will also be rolling out the raffle in Feb. We are asking all members here to get as many raffles prizes from their connections are possible. We will also need prizes for Grad Night.

Parents will be going into the Economics and Civics class to announce the raffle to the seniors and promote it. Raffles usually runs 2-3 weeks.

Renee reported that SJ Police Dept Swat will be doing security for the night.

We were reminded that the dress code for volunteering at Levi is Black slacks, white shirt, and black non-skid shoes.
