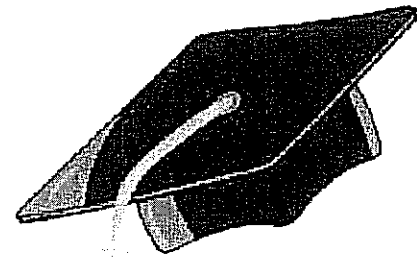

Senior checkout procedures

Seniors will receive their check-out form in 2nd period on Wednesday, May 30. All books must be turned in. If you have lost or damaged a book, the teacher must list title, book number and price on the checkout sheet. You will also need clearance from the library and ASB. All fines, books, and materials must be paid for by June 7, 2018. No checks will be accepted after May 4, 2018. Checkout form must be completed and returned to your counselor on June 7, 2018, from 11:00 AM - 1:00 PM. The senior survey must be completed before you can receive your cap and gown.

You will not receive your course grade until the "Senior Checkout" is completed. An incomplete or delayed Senior Checkout form may result in you not being able to participate in the graduation ceremony!

Senior Chromebook Return Procedures

Seniors must return their chromebooks in good working order. Chromebooks must be fully charged, cleaned, and all labels (including name tags) removed EXCEPT for the BARCODE LABEL. Chargers must be wrapped so that the barcode is visible. If you are having trouble with your chromebook, please take care of it now! If your chromebook screen is broken, your mouse is not working, the keys are sticking, or your computer is not charging properly, please contact your insurance company, if you have insurance, and follow their instructions for repair, or bring your chromebook to the library ASAP! Students presenting a broken computer which will not turn on, on checkout day, will be charged the full price of \$365. All fees must be paid prior to graduation.

Senior Disneyland Trip - Tuesday, June 5 to Wednesday, June 6

This trip will begin at approximately 7:00 AM on June 5, 2018 at Live Oak High School. Senior students will take charter busses to Disneyland (rest stops for food on the way). They will arrive at the park around 3:30 PM. From 3:30 PM to 10:00 PM they will be in Disneyland and from 10 PM -2 AM they will be in California Adventure. At 2:00 AM, students will board busses and depart back to Live Oak High School arriving at approximately 9 AM on June 6, 2018.

Senior Graduate Clearance - Thursday, June 7

All students are to line up at the counseling office starting at 11:00 AM on Thursday, June 7. You are to have all required signatures and course grades listed on your "Senior Check-out" sheet. Be sure to turn in your "Transcript Request" form along with your checkout form. Transcripts will be sent to the organization listed on the form once grades are finalized in June.

Graduation Practice - Thursday, June 7

Graduation practice will start at 1:30 PM on the tennis courts. The student line-up will be posted in the counseling, attendance, and ASB offices. Please know your row and seat assignment in advance. This will be a complete rehearsal of the graduation ceremony.

Final Graduation Rehearsal - Friday, June 8

All seniors will report to the football field by 9:00 AM. It is imperative for all graduating seniors to be on time and cooperative. We will be conducting a final rehearsal of the graduation ceremony.

GRADUATION CEREMONY - June 8, 2018

Seniors must report to the tennis courts by 1:00 PM. Graduates will be checked for appropriate attire and belongings. Graduates may either wear or bring their cap and gown. You will need large bobby pins to help secure your cap. Tassels should be worn over the right eye and not changed until everyone has received a diploma. The point of your cap should be in the middle of your forehead. **GRADUATION CAPS MAY NOT BE ALTERED OR DECORATED. APPROPRIATE ATTIRE IS MANDATORY!** No baseball caps, purses or view obstructing items are allowed. If anyone has misplaced a portion of their attire, a representative from Herff-Jones will be available to assist you.

Seniors will line-up at the tennis courts by 1:30 PM in their assigned positions to take roll. If arriving late, you will sit in the last row of the graduating class. At **2:00 PM sharp**, the processional music begins. Graduates will march toward the football field and sit in assigned seats.

The Grad Night Committee will be selling preferred parking spots for \$25. Please put your money in an envelope with your name and phone number on it and place it in the Grad Night Drop Box located in ASB.

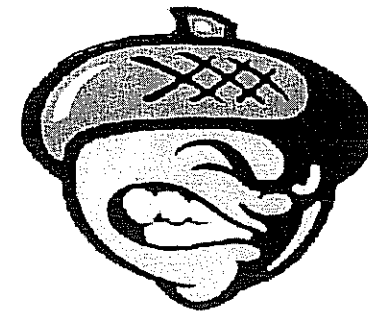


Senior Expectations
