# College Applications

- ▶ -Be aware of deadlines: Depending on the university students are applying to will depend on the deadline. The California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC) will be due on **Nov 30<sup>th</sup>**.
- ▶ Submit SAT/ACT scores: Be aware of deadlines to submit SAT/ACT scores. This will vary by university. Students will need to submit their SAT scores through **CollegeBoard.org (\$12.00 per school)**. Students will need to submit their ACT scores through **ACT.org (\$13.00 per school)**.
- ▶ When submitting SAT scores to CSU use code **3594**. When submitting ACT scores to CSU, send to 1 CSU and all CSU's will have access. When submitting SAT/ACT scores to UC, send score to 1 UC and all UC's will have access.

# College Applications Continued

- ▶ Once students apply, they will need to set up a portal/account with the school. This is how the school will communicate with them. Be aware of deadlines!
- ▶ Many of the community college applications will open 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. We will provide application support
- ▶ If attending a university, May 1, 2019 students will need to commit

# Naviance

- ▶ Students must report where they are applying on Naviance. This will allow necessary documents to be sent.
- ▶ If students need a letter of recommendation for university purposes, they should request the letter through Naviance.
- ▶ Once students have decided where they will be attending, they will need to report this on Naviance.

# Naviance Continued

- ▶ Students will request transcripts through Naviance.
- ▶ If students are getting letters of recommendations from their teachers, let me know so I can send the documents.
- ▶ Toward the end of the year, seniors will need to fill out their senior exit survey. This must be filled out before students pick up their cap and gown.



# Financial Aid

- ▶ Cal-SOAP will be hosting another Cash 4 College night Feb 13<sup>th</sup> 6:00-8:00 in the Library. You can get help filling out your Financial Aid applications (FAFSA).
- ▶ You will need your 2017 tax information.
- ▶ FAFSA deadline is March 2, 2019.
- ▶ Students/parents can make appointments with Counselors/Cal-SOAP to fill out FAFSA.
- ▶ Common Scholarship Application is due Nov 16<sup>th</sup>. Application, letter or rec, and personal statement.
- ▶ Additional scholarships can be found on Naviance. I would also advise to schedule a meeting with David de la Cuesta.
